BIT OF HISTORY

The Clark Candy Co. building was built as a factory in 1892. The site on which it stands is so germane to the roots of Old Allegheny Town, that the history of this ever changing neighborhood is worth remembering. James McClurg & Co. --Cracker Bakers and Confectioners was founded in 1869 and their showrooms were located on Wood Street in Pittsburgh, with a factory in Allegheny. A new six story brick factory was erected in 1892 on Martin and Rebecca Streets.

The David L. Clark Co. was founded in 1887 in a small house on Pittsburgh's North Side.

By 1911 the operation had grown rapidly and Mr. Clark purchased the McClurg factory.

Clark became the nation's largest candy maker. Many additions, improvements, and changes took place in the 75 years at this famous location. The D.L. Clark Co. Building

begun a new life in 1989 when the building was reopened with offices and the introduction of The Clark Bar & Grill, an immediate Pittsburgh institution.

We have been proudly serving the city of Pittsburgh since the days of Three Rivers Stadium and continue today with our central location between PNC Park and Heinz Field. In an ever evolving region of the city, The Clark Bar & Grill has remained a constant tradition.
